This role focuses on identifying new prospects, stewarding an existing portfolio of donors, partnering with the CDO to manage and develop relationships with Jewish Federations in the northeast and implementing major gifts fundraising strategies to support the mission of ORT America. The ideal candidate will have a proven record of accomplishment in major gifts fundraising, excellent relationship-building skills, and a passion for advancing education as a gateway to success through ORT's global network of schools and programs.

Key Responsibilities

Prospect Identification and Cultivation:

- o Identify and research potential major gift prospects within the Northeast region.
- Develop and implement strategies to cultivate relationships with new donors.
- Maintain a robust pipeline of major gift prospects.

Major Gifts Fundraising:

- Develop and execute major gift fundraising strategies to meet annual revenue goals.
